**BIG WINS IN 2023:**

We helped organize the annual Food Security Fly-In week in Juneau advocating for addressing the SNAP backlog;

- We provided recommendations to **Senator Murkowski's office** in developing the Improving ARCTIC Act;
- We supported **Alaska Food Strategy Task Force** and the release of the 2023 report;
- We co-hosted the **2023 Food and Farm Festival** in Anchorage Alaska;
- We laid the groundwork for an **AmeriCorps program focused on food security**;
- We launched the **AK Food Recovery Dashboard** via the Food Waste Working Group;
- We created an Alaska Food Hub Working Group and co-produced an **Operations & Food Safety Manual with the DEC**, along with a Recommendations report;
- We provided input and feedback on the report: ***Food Security and Sovereignty in Alaska Native Communities: Recommendations for Improving Language and Inclusivity in Food and Agriculture Programming***, via our Indigenous Foods Working Group.
